ABOUT THE COLLEGE

LOKANAYAK OMEO KUMAR DAS COLLEGE was established on 15th July 1970 with the Stream of Arts. During its inception it was named as "Dhekiajuli College" but later on in the year 1975 it was renamed as "Lokanayak Omeo Kumar Das College" after leading Gandhian leader late Omeo Kumar Das. At present it imparts education to more than four thousand students with streams of Arts, Science and Commerce. The College is situated at the gateway of Dhekiajuli (also known as Swahid Nagari for its contribution in Quit India movement) by the road side of NH 15. The small town of Dhekiajuli has a place of pride in the history of Indian anti-imperialist struggle. 20th September, 1942 is etched in the collective memory of the people of Dhekiajuli as a day of remembrance for the martyrdom of 13 freedom fighters which is an example of extraordinary contribution in the larger Indian context. The College is accredited with B+ by NAAC.

LOCATION OF THE COLLEGE :

The road distance of the college is about 35 km from Tezpur and 128.4 km from Guwahati. The College is about 35 km away from Tezpur airport and 134 km from Lokapriya Gopinath Bordoloi International airport, Guwahati. As for conveyance, it is 13 km away from 'Dhekiajuli Road' Railway station.
